**Important Information**

Please remember to stick to your child's drop off time and collection time. If you have more than one child, stick with the time for the oldest sibling.

We will continue to stagger arriving and departing school as well as breaktimes and lunchtimes to ensure that these bubbles do not mix when in school. Please take note of these new timings.

**Other things to remember –**

- Children must wear school uniform
- Years 3/4/5/6 children must be dropped off and collected from the school gate
- On PE days children can come dressed in their PE kit
- Children are not to bring in items from home – they will be provided with equipment at school
- All adults dropping/collecting children must wear a mask
- When collecting children at the gate please socially distance from other families
- The school office is closed – please call to make an appointment

**To ensure that we can ALL stay as safe as possible –**

Please remember if your child or anyone in your household shows **ANY** of the following symptoms:

- A high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- A new continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- A loss or change to their sense of smell or taste – this means you have noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.
