Safety

Please remember that the Yellow **zig zag** road markings outside our school are placed to show that the area must be kept clear to allow an unrestricted view for approaching drivers and riders or children wanting to cross the road. This is to ensure that all of our children stay safe.

Recently there has been a police patrol checking that this is being enforced. If seen parking/pulling up on these lines they are issuing fines.



To ensure that we can ALL stay as safe as possible –

Please remember if your child or anyone in your household shows **ANY** of the following symptoms:

- A high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- A new continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- A loss or change to their sense of smell or taste – this means you have noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

You MUST get a test ASAP. Contact 119 or book a test online at –

Do not bring your child into school and you must isolate and wait for the result of your test. Please inform school **0115 917 4310** if your child receives a positive result to ensure that we can act ASAP.
